



Recital 2020 Amendment

Due to the extenuating circumstances we are experiencing with the COVID-19 Pandemic crisis in Houston, we have formally made the difficult decision to postpone our first annual recital to the end of our spring 2021 semester (May/June 2021).

Any payment that has already been made towards our Red Carpet Premiere Recital in 2020 will be applied towards the fees for next spring's recital (still our Red Carpet Premiere Recital). For example, if you paid the full single costume fee of \$190 in March 2020, you will be considered paid in full for the 2021 single costume recital fees and will not be impacted by any price increase in 2021. *(Recital fees for 2021 have not been calculated yet, but we anticipate there may be a need to increase the price slightly due to social distancing requirements calling for additional space rental time and distancing measures.)* If, however, you would like to receive your purchased costume, please let us know by July 24th and we will find a way to get it to you. In this case, unless your child is performing in the same class and the same costume still fits next spring, you will be charged half of the recital fees in 2021.

If you signed the 2020 Recital Participation form and paid the first half payment and will **not** be able to participate in the 2021 Recital due to the pandemic, we will provide an account credit, which can be used to take dance classes. If you would like to receive your costume instead of taking the account credit, please let us know by July 24th.

If you signed the 2020 Recital Participation form and paid the full payment and will **not** be able to participate in the 2021 Recital due to the pandemic, we will provide an account credit, which can be used to take dance classes. If you are unable to take the dance classes, you may request a refund in the amount of half of the recital fees. If you would like to receive your costume we will reduce the credit by half and provide the costume to you, but please let us know by July 24th.

We hope that you understand that we have set these options in place due to the fact that we have already purchased all of the costumes and costume companies will not provide refunds.

For some students, the decision to commit to the 2021 recital is easy. For others, we know this may be a difficult decision to make at this point in time, so please reach out to us for any clarifying questions.
